The Intersection of Domestic Violence and Child Welfare:

A Joint Training for Child Welfare Staff and Domestic Violence Advocates

Though many families experiencing domestic violence also interface with the Child Welfare System, there is a historic disconnect between the two fields. While each has different perspectives that guide their work, this training will work to bring the groups together to improve efforts in supporting families and their children impacted by domestic violence.
