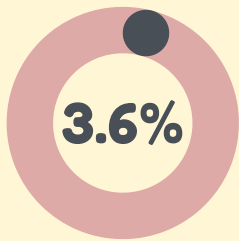

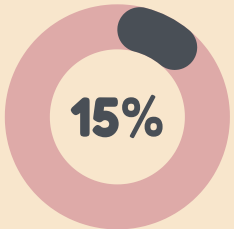

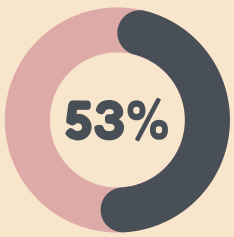

Among family planning clinics,

Girls who are victims of dating violence are

4-6x more likely

to become pregnant than non-abused girls.
